

#### Read Genesis 9:11-17




Talk about your family.

# Jacob and Esau



### Read Genesis 37-45


Jacob had twelve sons but Joseph was his favourite and he gave him a special coat. Joseph's brothers were jealous and one day they attacked him and sold him as a slave. Joseph ended up in Egypt where he became a very important advisor to the king. God helped Joseph to understand the king's dream and helped to save the country from famine. Eventually Joseph was reunited with his own family when they came to Egypt to buy food. Joseph's family made their home in Egypt. The story of Joseph is on p22-27 of the Storyteller's Bible.

Talk What have you had to eat today? Can we do anything to help people who don't have enough to eat?

### Read Exodus 3:1-12


Joseph's family grew so much in Egypt that the people became afraid of them and they made them into slaves. But God heard the prayers of these slaves. One day a man called Moses heard God speak to him through a burning bush. God told Moses that he had been chosen to lead the people out of slavery in Egypt to a new home in a different country and that God would help him to do this. # Miriam

### Read Exodus 15:20-27

Moses went to see the King of Egypt. But he refused to let the people go - they were very useful as slaves. Only after the country had suffered all kinds of plagues did the King agree to release the slaves. But then he instructed his army to stop them. With God's help the people crossed the Red Sea to safety. Miriam, wrote a song about their escape - you can read about the escape on p32-33 of the Storyteller's Bible.

Talk What do you think it was like to be a slave?

Pray Thank God for our freedom and pray for those who are slaves today
